Community Funding

enfinium can support:

- registered charities
- schools
- places of learning
- not for profit organisations (including those supported by public funding)

for any one of the following causes:

- the environment (for example the promotion of clean energy, waste reduction and/or recycling improvement)
- education
- improved standards of health, safety and wellbeing
- social inclusion and community wellbeing
- young people
- the enhancement of the wider community (including skills and educational development, environmental improvements and activities that improve community cohesion).





What is the criteria?

Applications must demonstrate that their project and/or organisation's work:

- is aligned with our supported causes (set out above)
- supports people and/or communities that live in or around the areas in which we operate (usually within a 10-15-mile radius of the following locations):
 - » Ferrybridge, Knottingley, Yorkshire WF11 8DX
 - » Kemsley, Sittingbourne, Kent ME10 2FP
 - » Parc Adfer, Deeside, Flintshire CH5 2LL
 - » Skelton Grange, Leeds, Yorkshire LS10 1FQ
 - » Kelvin, West Bromwich, West Midlands B70 7JR

Organisations outside of these areas are eligible to apply, as long as they can prove how the award of funding will have a beneficial impact on our host communities.

In addition, applications will need to:

- be for specific projects or initiatives and not general requests to support day-to-day running costs, pay salaries or pay for reserve funding
- not involve sponsorship of an individual or advertising
- be for funds that would fall outside of the normal local authority or government funding responsibilities.
